2nd ANNUAL RHSAA ALUMNI BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT NETS OVER \$2500 FOR SCHOLARSHIP FUND by Crystal Longwell

On March 24, 25, and 26, 2005, the second annual alumni basketball tournament was held at River's R.L. Potts gymnasium. Crystal Longwell (1989), RHSAA Vice President, coordinated the tourney. Many alumni assisted her in various areas. This tournament began in 2004 and all proceeds are placed in the RHSAA Scholarship Fund. Last year the proceeds enabled the number of scholarships awarded to be increased from two to four.

Everyone is talking about this tourney! If you attended, sometimes you saw 3 or 4 generations involved in the tourney either as spectators or players. All ages enjoyed the event and truly demonstrated how this activity brings alumni together. These **six men's teams** competed in double elimination: '75-'79, '80-'84, '85-'89, '90-'94, '95-'99, '00-'04. **Two women's teams** played for the first time in this tournament.

Each day of the tournament began with the **singing of the National Anthem**-- On Thursday evening, the Hannibal Kindergarten class; on Friday night, Lea Baker (2002) and on Saturday, Candy (Clipner) Baker (1979).

Other activities new this year included a **Jr. High 3-point shot contest**. Jordan Clegg, son of Chuck (1983) and Mary Clegg of Clarington won the boy's division and Chelsea Lowe, daughter of Jeff (79) and Valerie (Crawford) Williamson (1983) and Craig Lowe of Paden City, WV took home the trophy for the girl's division. Erika Williams of Sardis and Brandon Sprouse of Hannibal won the **Jr. High foul shot contest** also held on Thursday evening.

On Friday night between the girl's game and the men's Game 3, five grads participated in an **Old-Timer's Shootout** before a large crowd. Bill Beisel (1965), Charlie Isaly (1956), Raymond Raper (1957), Ron Sebring (1962), and Max Wohnhas (1954, Sardis High School) sank hook shots and baseline jumpers. After several minutes Bill Beisel received a Bob Evans gift certificate for winning the First Old-Timer's Shootout.

Prior to the Championship game, **team '54-'55, the first RHS basketball team, was honored.** Names of all 12 players was read along with the inscription on the plaque that each team member would receive. Joe Dierkes, a team member, was present to receive his award from Crystal Longwell, RHSAA Vice President and tournament organizer.

Other team members present throughout the weekend event, but not on hand for the ceremony were: Paul Brown, Charlie Isaly, and Raymond Raper. Team members not present were: William Ball, Artie Clegg, Keith Dierkes, Mylen Haight, Lynn Jackson, Dave Lohri, Dale Warner, Charlie Clegg, & Ed Repco, who is deceased.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE GAMES

On Thursday night, the first tournament game between team '90-'94 and '00-'04 saw the young team win 63-52. High scorers were '90-'94 Eric Fuchs with 17 and '00-'04 Chris Isaly with 21.

Game 2 saw '75-'79 go up against team '95-'99. The "old guys" rolled to a 68-63 win. Team '75-'79 Scooter Tolzda had 27 and team '95-'99 Justin Isaly made 21.

Day 2 started with the ladies "red" vs. "gray" team and the "red" won 36-24. Tamara (Sebring) Gibson (1991) led the winners with 11 points, while Sherri (Arnold) Fijalkowski (1989) had 9 for the gray team.

Men's Game 3 had the defending champions, team '85-'89, going up against the '00-'04 team who had won Game 1. The young guys won 67-63. High scorers for team '85-'89 were Rob Fuchs with 19 and Jim Eveland with 16. Chris Isaly netted 20 for the winners.

In Game 4 '80-'84 challenged team '75-'79, and '80-'84 won 53-46. Jon Dierkes led his team with 21 as Dean Caldwell paced the losers with 11.

On Saturday, Game 5 saw the '85-'89 team take on the '95-'99 team. Justin Isaly's bucket at the buzzer sealed the game for the '95-'99 team, 62-60. Leading scorers for the '85-'89 team were Jim Eveland with 25 and Rob Fuchs with 17. Justin Isaly netted 19 and Brandon Grimes chipped in 18 for the winners.

Game 6 followed as team '75-'79 challenged team '90-'94. The score was close throughout the game as team '75-'79 held on for a 54-51 win. Leading team '75-'79 were John Miller with 13 and Rick Isaly and Scooter Tolzda with 12 each. Eric Fuchs netted 26 for the losers.

At noon, team '80-'84 took on team '00-'04. The "older" guys led the entire first half and took a 36-24 lead into the locker room at the break. In the second half the younger team fought back and won 66-58. Team '00-'04 saw Chris Isaly tally 11 and Ryan Potts sink 10. Leading the way for '80-'84 was Jon Dierkes with 28 while Brent Isaly garnered 15.

The 1:30 p.m. match up had team '95-'99 going up against team '75-'79. Brandon Grimes had 19, and Mike Gehrig netted 14 as the '95-'99 team went on to win 67-55. Dean Caldwell had 19 and Mike Lollathin contributed 10 for the losers.

The first overtime of the weekend event occurred with team '80-'84 and team '95-'99 being tied up at 61 at the end of regulation for Game 9 at 3:00 p.m. As the bonus period started team '80-'84 took off and never looked back as they went on to win 71-63. Rob Caldwell led the winners with 18 while Jon Dierkes chipped in with 16 and Shannon Wohnhas netted 13. Mike Gehrig had 25 for the losers.

Game 10 began immediately following the awards ceremony for the 1954-1955 team and saw team '80-'84 take on team '00-'04. The final score was 69-62 and team '00-'04 became the winners of the 2nd Annual RHSAA Alumni Tournament. Leading the winners were Chris Isaly with 26 points and Ethan Hulsey with 12. The losers saw Rob Caldwell net 17 and Brent Isaly sank 14.

The weekend event raised over \$2,500 for the Alumni Association's Scholarship Fund. The Alumni Association would like to thank all of those individuals who helped in any way, whether it was sponsoring a team, playing, working or donating supplies. Next year's event is scheduled to take place on April 13, 14, and 15, 2006.
