RIVER ALUMNI TO HELP BUY A/C'S FOR RHS COMPUTER CLASSROOMS & LIBRARY **CAN YOU STEP UP TO THE PLATE & DONATE?**

The RHSAA Board members toured part of the high school during their March board meeting. The Board is working on a list of possible service projects for RHS. Improving the environment in the computer classrooms where Tim Frye and Gregg Swords teach Business Foundation and Multi-Media I and II is at the top of the list. Some English classes also use the rooms to compose essays, etc. The average number of students who use the computer classrooms on a daily basis is 140 students. How would you feel working on the computer if the temperature in the room rose to 98 degrees on the warm days? Probably not the greatest. Think the computer would like it? Probably not. Maybe extra maintenance needed? Probably yes.

Three A/C units, each with a 13,800 BTU's, were required with two units in the larger room and one unit in the smaller room. Also, the library needs to replace an 8,000 BTU with a 12,000 BTU unit. You need a wrench to turn the current unit on and off. These 4 units installed cost at least \$1,600.00.

So, can you step up to the plate & donate? Whether you live far away or nearby, does not matter. Whether you donate \$25.00 or \$50.00 or \$100.00, etc. does not matter. 5th Annual River High School Alumni Association **Basketball Tournament**

On March 21 and 22, 2008 the River High School Alumni Association hosted our fifth annual Alumni Basketball Tournament. The profit from the 2008 tourney was approximately \$1,000. All proceeds from this event go into the RHSAA Scholarship Fund. In 2004, 4 students were awarded \$250.00 each. For 2005, 6 students received \$350.00 each. In the third year of the tourney, 2006, 6 more students won \$350.00 each. In 2007, 6 students again received \$350.00 each. As a result, from 2004 through 2007, 22 students earned \$7,300.00 in scholarship money. Scholarships were awarded in 2001, 2002, & 2003 to 6 students with \$250.00 each before the alumni tournament began. So you can see that this Alumni Tournament has really helped River students get scholarship funds.
