Start receiving your Newsletter by E-MAIL!



Our newsletter consultant, Dona Cernus, is mailing 1,100 newsletters electronically using the Constant Contact service. The RHSAA pays her to send the electronic as well as paper letters. It is a lot less expensive for us to send electronic newsletters than paper. If we do not have an e-mail address for you, then you will get your newsletter in the postal mail along with about 3,500 others. We only plan to e-mail a notice of fundraisers and the annual newsletter each year. We will not sell the e-mail addresses. The subject line will show **River High Alumni Hannibal**, **OH Newsletter 2015.** It will identify that it is from River High Alumni Committee and sent from barbarathode@gmail.com. (The postal letters show Barbara Thode's address in Marietta). If you receive the newsletter by e-mail, it can be forwarded to a classmate(s), you can change your e-mail address if you get a different e-mail in the future, or you can unsubscribe & we will send you a paper copy the following year.

If you hear that someone never got an e-mail or paper newsletter, direct them to our website, www.riverhighalumni.org, where they can read the newsletter. (Make sure it is this website.) The classmate can sign up to receive the newsletter electronically next year. To register for the reunion or send dues or donations, print out the newsletter from the website and send it by postal mail.

Going digital saves us tremendous postage costs. The last time we mailed newsletters, more than 4,500 went through the post office, and hundreds of them covered two or more names at the same address. RHSAA paid \$1,425.00 for postage alone.
