LANDSCAPING IMPROVEMENTS CONTINUE AT RIVER CAMPUS

Last year stone & concrete edging were installed in front of the school by 1996 RHS grad Milan Indermuhle's business. This summer the area in the circle drive has had stone & concrete added. A new flagpole is being installed. RHSAA reimbursed the school \$3,200.00 in March, 2017. Plans are drawn up for the remainder of the campus to be completed in different phases.
